Leader All	We do not pursue meaningful relationships in community. We project an image, keep our distance, and deflect real connection. We're scared to know and be known.		
Leader All	The beauty we create does not point to the creator God who made us creative. We work to make a name for ourselves, instead of working to reflect the greatness of Jesus' name.		
Leader All	We struggle in evangelism and mistake silence for respect. We suppose that Jesus is just one of many ways to peace and fulfillment, so we have nothing to offer our neighbor.		
Leader	Father, Son, and Spirit, rebuild us in your grace.		
All	Make us a home where you live, joined together in Christ Jesus, to be satisfied in and to show off your goodness and glory to the world.

# **Call to Communion**

#### Guidelines for the Reception of Communion

Redeemer welcomes to Communion all Christians who are willing to forsake their sin and trust in Jesus Christ for salvation and who are members of congregations which proclaim the gospel. We will be coming forward for the distribution of Communion. Please use the hand sanitizer. You will receive the bread into your hands and take a cup from the tray. Clear cups (located in the interior rings) contain grape juice. Red cups (exterior ring of tray) contain wine. Wait to eat the bread and drink the wine until we all do so together, once we are back in our seats. Children who have been interviewed by the elders are able to share in Communion.

Communion is a time of connection with the Lord Jesus and with each other. Feel free to sing with the band during Communion. The ministry of prayer is also a way we live together as a community of believers and seekers. Please take the time to pray on your own, or with someone else in the pews.

#### Prayer for Guidance to Truth

#### Prayer of Belief and Repentance

I now turn away from all I have been doing. I turn away from my self-centered life. I turn my whole heart toward you. I believe that when you were crucified, you took all of my evil and somehow you gave me all of your beauty. I invite your Holy Spirit to live in me. I do not want to live for myself any more. I want you to lead my life. I want to know you and to receive your love for me. Please teach me and protect me and guide me. I am yours. I ask these things in the name of Jesus. Amen.

#### Prayer of Doubt and Faith

I am confused by the fact that there are so many things that I don't understand or that make me angry about you. There are also so many things that fill my heart with hope and many things that draw me to you, and I want to put my trust in you.
