Sermon

Ben Reed Eternal Hope in a Dark World

Community Group Questions

1) Peter tells us to always be ready to give a defense of the hope we have but to do it with gentleness and respect. What are traits of a defense filled with gentleness and respect? And what are traits that must be absent for our defense to be filled with gentles and respect?

2) We are called to live out our hope in word and deed, but most of us struggle to do both of those well. What is harder for you to do publicly: tell others about the hope you have in Jesus, or live in a radical way that shows your hope to others? Why do you think it is so difficult for you?

3) Human nature is to blend in. We want to reflect enough of our eternal hope so people know we're a good person, but we don't want to stand out and be considered weird. What are the biggest roadblocks for you in more publicly declaring the hope you have in your words and deeds? If you feel comfortable, share them with the group and spend time praying for each other.

Children's Question

The Apostle Peter tells us that we should always be ready to tell people about the hope we have in Jesus. Is it easy or hard for you to tell people about that? We're not only supposed to tell people with our words, but our actions are supposed to show people that we love Jesus. What do you think it means for your actions to show people you love Jesus? What kinds of things would you do (or not do)?

Call to Communion and Prayer

Guidelines for the Reception of Communion

Redeemer welcomes all Christians who are willing to forsake their sin and trust in Jesus Christ for salvation and who are members of congregations which proclaim the gospel to receive Communion with us. We will be coming forward for the distribution of Communion. Please eat the bread privately, and then drink the cup together with us after everyone has returned to their seats. Clear cups (located in the interior rings) contain grape juice. Red cups (exterior ring of tray) contain wine. Children who have been interviewed by the elders are able to partake of Communion.

The ministry of prayer is one of the ways we live together as a community of believers and seekers. During Communion, members of our prayer team are available at the front of the sanctuary. It would be our privilege to pray with you as we walk together through the joys and struggles of life. We also encourage you to pray with one another in the pews during this time of movement in our service.
