Community Group Questions

- 1) Do you have a particular area where you are prone to doubt the love of God and feel separated from the love of Christ? What causes doubt and/or belief in that area?
- 2) Share some of the tangible reminders or 'self talk' that you give yourself when you are tempted to feel separated from the love of Christ. How do you experience lasting security in your Savior?
- 3) This is less complicated to practice with ourselves when we tend to doubt God's goodness, but it's trickier to share this with others. How do you lovingly tell somebody they are conquering when they are facing trouble, without minimizing their hardship?

Call to Communion

Guidelines for the Reception of Communion

Redeemer welcomes all Christians who are willing to forsake their sin and trust in Jesus Christ for salvation and who are members of congregations which proclaim the gospel to receive Communion with us. We will be coming forward for the distribution of Communion. Please use the hand sanitizer. You will receive the bread into your hands and take a cup from the tray. Clear cups (located in the interior rings) contain grape juice. Red cups (exterior ring of tray) contain wine. Wait to eat the bread and drink the wine until we all do so together, once we are back in our seats. Children who have been interviewed by the elders are able to share in Communion.

Communion is a time of connection with the Lord Jesus and with each other. Feel free to sing with the band during Communion. The ministry of prayer is also a way we live together as a community of believers and seekers. Please take the time to pray on your own, or with someone else in the pews (in a socially distanced way).
